Neighborhood Camp FACTS Sheet

What are the current camp sites and who is eligible to attend?

- In 2019, hosting congregations are Living Faith, Emaus, Lutheran Church of the Redeemer, and the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection.
- Church members, together with neighborhood children who live in the zip code(s) area of the host church are invited to register. Completed registration forms are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The overall capacity at each site averages 55 elementary and 15 middle school children.

What ages are the campers?

- Neighborhood Campers are children who will be entering 1st through 6th grade in the fall following camp
- SALT (Serving and Learning Together) is a middle school program that specializes in service opportunities around our city.

What meals are provided at Neighborhood Camp?

- Campers receive a nutritious, well-balanced breakfast and lunch daily. Healthy afternoon snacks are also provided. All meals meet the meal requirements set by the Department of Public Instruction

Camp Facts:

Through 30 minutes of “God Time” daily lead by Pastor and Lay Leaders, our campers learn and experience God’s love first-hand through biblical stories, songs and prayer.

- Camp is a place to expand the world view of campers through new and exciting weekly themes.
- Campers engage in a minimum of 30 minutes of outdoor activities daily (weather permitting).
- Campers participate in the Barnes and Noble summer reading program.
- Campers engage in journaling, hands-on art and science projects, and field trips related to the weekly themes.

Daily Schedule

8:15 am-9:15 am: Breakfast

9:15 am: Arrival for campers not eating breakfast- Quiet games and Library time for checking in/out and recording books for Barnes & Noble summer reading program.

9:45 am: Circle Time - "meet 'n greet", action songs and overview of the day.

10:00 am: God Time - Pastor led Bible story which may include singing and camper skit.

10:30 am: Large motor skill group games for younger campers on the field. Theme related project for older campers

11:15 am: Younger campers transition to lunch.

12:00pm: Story time and library opportunity for younger campers. Older campers transition to lunch

12:45pm: Theme related project for younger campers; Library and reading time for the older campers.

1:30pm: Free time may include an art project, outdoor games or quiet games and puzzles or journaling.

2:00pm: Journaling - each camper has the opportunity to write and/or draw about their experiences during the day.

2:30pm: Snack

2:45pm: Closing circle time

3:30pm: Camp ends for the day.
