

Greetings People of LCR,


It has been almost a year since the COVID virus changed our world as we know it. We have certainly learned how to worship and carry out the mission and ministry of LCR in many different ways and we have been challenged to be God's people more than ever. It is a blessing to see the vaccines starting to be distributed to the first 2 groups of people and infection rates continuing to stay lower.

As Council, the Worship Committee and staff have reviewed information from the Wisconsin Council of Churches, our Synod Bishop Paul Erickson, the CDC, and the Racine County Health Department, we believe that at this time we can start to offer a transitional worship plan as of March 7 to once again have in person worship in our sanctuary at 10am. In person worship will have limited attendance on limited dates at this time and we will also continue with online worship and drive-in worship as well.

As you can see in the schedule below, this transitional schedule will offer different worship options through mid-April. Council will review how things are going along the way and update the congregation with additional worship plans, especially after Easter. There are still so many variables regarding COVID, variant strains, kids returning to school, etc...that we want to make sure we are providing the safest worship environment as possible for everyone.

If you will be joining us for worship in person please remember; most importantly PLEASE stay home when you are sick, wear a mask over your nose and mouth, stay at least 6 feet from other people (just because you are okay with hugging - not everyone else is), know that worship will be different than it was before and we hope over time we will be able to bring more things back to the way they were....but it is going to take time. Please be patient.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR DRIVE-IN WORSHIP:


- · Online Pre-Registration Requested
