Greetings Lutheran Church of the Resurrection Members & Friends,

One year ago, the coronavirus outbreak was declared a pandemic by the World Health Organization, and we held our last in person sanctuary worship service until this past weekend. During this whole past year, we have certainly continued to worship together through online worship, outdoor worship and drive-in worship.

We have learned a lot about what it means to be God's people this past year. We have also learned how to be flexible in times when we certainly feel out of our comfort zones, how to continue to connect with one another in different ways and certainly to remember that even in the toughest times God's steadfast love endures.

Many of you keep asking me, when will things return to "normal" Pastor Karen? I wish I had the answer to that...because it would make all our lives a lot easier! This past year has not been easy on any of us and we all know that we want to get back to "normal" or at least the post pandemic new normal because we cannot go through this past year without being changed in some way, shape or form from this experience. Yes, it is a blessing to finally see the light of new possibilities, yet we can't forget all those who have lost loved ones due to Covid and all those who have long term health issues because of Covid.

What I can tell you is, as we have started our transitional worship schedule please know we are trying our best to provide the safest worship environment for all of our LCR members, knowing that not everyone has had a chance to get their vaccine shots yet. So, for now we will still have recorded music, we will not be singing inside until vaccine rates are much much higher, we will still be wearing masks as we gather for worship, and we will still have socially distanced seating. If we fill up the 10am worship service, then we will add an additional service.

As of today, in Racine County 9.0% (17,728) of its residents have completed the COVID vaccine series, so we are a still a bit away from returning back to "normal" yet. Council will continue to review COVID case numbers, vaccine rates, our worship attendance numbers, and we will make adjustments along the way, continuing to communicate information out to the members and friends of LCR. Remember we are all trying our best to live out the greatest commandment in these ever-changing times. So, let this be at the center of our hearts like Jesus said; 37 "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" (*Matt 22:37-38*).

It is amazing to know we were, we are and will continue to be God's people blessed to be a community of faith called together and sent by Jesus to share the Resurrection by Loving Jesus, Changing Lives and Reaching Out to Serve.

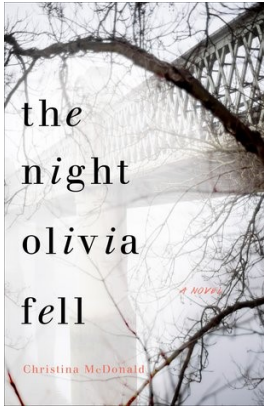
