Frances Helen Holter (nee Schultz)

January 8, 1929 – April 19, 2021

RACINE - Frances Holter was born January 8, 1929 to Luther and Hattie (Yeska) Schultz in Hinsdale, Montana; she passed away April 19, 2021 in Racine, Wisconsin at the age of 92.

- Lead acid car batteries
- Appliances: Refrigerators, dryers, microwaves, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, commercial coolers, dishwashers, furnaces, freezers, clothes washers, hot water heaters, kitchen ranges/overs, thermostats, drinking fountains, trash compactors, vending machines
