

Council President Note:

LCR -

This past week the COVID world and changes accelerated again. Many organizations and government entities decided to lift mandatory Mask Mandates. I want to share with you the process the Council went through and talk about what this means to all of us.

The Council met on February 21st and we discussed that if mandates start to drop in Racine, we will consider removing the mandate at LCR. Since we only meet monthly if this would accelerate prior to our next meeting, we would call the Executive Council together and determine what our pathway should be.

On Friday February 25th, the Executive Council was gathered for the visioning process, and we called a meeting to discuss the masking at LCR. During that meeting we agreed that we should remove the tape from the pews and make masks optional at LCR.

This process was quick. While many of us are excited to be able to see faces and engage each other in a normal way within the Church, moving away from Masking in public setting is not something that everyone is ready to do for a number of reasons: underlying conditions, care for a non-vaccinated person, being un-vaccinated, interaction with a lot of others on a daily basis, and other personal reasons.

As a loving community of faith and acceptance of all thoughts and ideas, I ask that we all continue to respect the individual decisions that others are making regarding masking. As you see someone, including our Pastors, wearing a mask, please be respectful of social distancing and allow the masked individual to take the lead in how close they feel comfortable engaging with you.

It is important in this new phase of COIVD, hopefully the end, that we continue to respect individual decisions


PRIME TIMERS EVENT MARCH 8


