Dear Sisters in Christ,

The Greater Milwaukee Synodical Organization of Women of the ELCA held its annual convention on October 9th of last year. A resolution was brought forth during the convention which asked the board to prayerfully consider disbanding the organization. Please read the copy of the full resolution that is included with this letter. The resolution was passed by the voting members present at the convention.

In keeping with the resolution, the board members consulted with the executive director of Women of the ELCA, Linda Post-Buskofsky. She informed the board that the constitution does not have a provision for the dissolution of the synodical organization. However, as of October 8, 2022 the president, vice-president, treasurer, and all of the remaining board members will leave office. During the last few years there have been no women who have come forward who are willing to be nominated as officers or board members. If there are none this year, the organization will be left without a working board and will not be able to continue and the organization will become inactive.

To recap:

- There is a resolution on the table to possibly disband the SWO.
- We've had no women willing to be nominated to board positions for the last few years.
- As of October 2022 all of the board members will leave office.
- If there are no women nominated for board positions, the SWO will become inactive.
- There will be a gathering of the SWO on October 8th. All women of ELCA congregations are invited to attend.

If congregational units truly want this organization to continue, they must diligently pray for women to be willing to be nominated. Resolution to Consider Disbanding the ELCA Greater Milwaukee Synodical Women's Organization (SWO)

- Whereas, our members have been aging out of participation, new women have not been joining, and fewer women have been attending meetings;
- Whereas, members have not been willing to serve on the nomination committee to fill openings on the SWO board, and for several years no nominations have been received when a general call for nominations was sent out to the membership:
- Whereas, financial support for SWO has steadily decreased which leads to a decrease of offerings available to send to the Churchwide Organization; and
- Whereas, the Greater Milwaukee SWO board members have continued to meet to do the business of the SWO and have been in touch with some local congregational leaders to understand the current status of the SWO; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that Women of the ELCA Greater Milwaukee Synodical Women's Organization (SWO) Board:

- be asked to prayerfully consider disbanding the current Greater Milwaukee SWO;
- 2. be asked to consider the opinions of members attending the October 9, 2021 SWO Convention;
- 3. be asked to research the official process for disbanding the Greater Milwaukee SWO; and
- 4. be asked to report out the decision of the SWO Board and the final treasurer's report in the organization newsletter, *Gleanings*, if the decision is made to disband.
