### BAPTISM OF MILEY JO BROOK

God, who is rich in mercy and love... for the life of the world.

Called by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the grace and love of God, do you desire to have **Miley Jo** baptized into Christ?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

As you bring **Miley** to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with responsibilities...

Do you promise to help **Miley** grow in the Christian faith and life?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

People of God, do you promise to support **Miley** and pray for her in her new life in Christ?

**We do.**

*Congregation may stand as you are able.*

To all the baptized, I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you believe in God the Father?

**I believe in God, the Father almighty,  
creator of heaven and earth.**

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

**I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried;  
he descended to the dead.**

**On the third day he rose again;  
he ascended into heaven,  
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,  
and he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

**I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting.**

We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and by your Word you created the world, calling forth life in which you took delight. Through the waters of the flood you delivered Noah and his family, and through the sea you led your people Israel from slavery into freedom. At the river your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Holy Spirit. By the baptism of Jesus' death and resurrection you set us free from the power of sin and death and raise us up to live in you.

Pour out your Holy Spirit, the power of your living Word, that those who are washed in the waters of baptism may be given new life. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.

**Amen.**

*Congregation may be seated.*

**Miley**, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Let us pray. We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give your daughters and sons new birth, cleanse them from sin, and raise them to eternal life. Sustain **Miley** with the gift of your Holy Spirit: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence, both now and forever.

**Amen.**

**Miley**, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

**Amen.**

We present this candle to you as a reminder of your baptism and the word of Jesus to, *"Let your light so shine before others that they might see your good works and glorify your Father in Heaven."* Let us welcome the newly baptized.

**We welcome Miley into the body of Christ and into the mission we share: giving thanks and praise to God so that we can bear God's creative and redeeming word to all the world.**

**PRAYER OF THE DAY**

Let us pray.... Faithful God,

**You prospered the work of Joseph's hands, in good times and bad. Give us Joseph's unfailing love for you, that by the power of your Holy Spirit, we might overcome whatever life throws at us. Amen.**

**A READING FROM GENESIS 37, 39, 41, 42 & 50(CEV, selected verses)**

*In Genesis chapter 12, which we read last week, God promised Abraham many descendants. Abraham's son Isaac had a son named Jacob, who was later renamed "Israel". Jacob had 12 sons. This is the story of those brothers, especially Joseph.*

Jacob loved Joseph more than he did any of his other sons, and so Joseph's brothers hated him and would not be friendly to him. [One day] the brothers saw Joseph coming and made plans to kill him. [One of the brothers] tried to protect Joseph from them. [So, instead] they threw Joseph into a dry well. A little while later, they sold Joseph to slave traders who took him to Egypt. [Meanwhile] the traders took Joseph to Egypt and sold him to Potiphar, the king's official in charge of the palace guard. Soon Potiphar realized that the LORD was helping Joseph to be successful in whatever he did. Potiphar liked Joseph and made him his personal assistant, putting him in charge of his house and all of his property. Because of Joseph, the LORD began to bless Potiphar's family and fields. Potiphar's wife soon noticed Joseph, and said, "Lie with me.", but he refused and said, "I won't sin against God by doing such a terrible thing as this." [So the Master's wife tricked Joseph, and lied to her husband, and Potifar was convinced that his servant had betrayed him.] Potiphar became very angry and threw Joseph in prison. While Joseph was in prison, the LORD helped him and was good to him. He even made the jailer like Joseph so much that he put him in charge of the other prisoners and of everything that was done in the jail. The LORD was with Joseph and made him successful in all that he did. [After many years, Joseph was removed from prison and became an advisor to the king] The king told Joseph, "God is the one who has shown you these things. You are now governor of all Egypt!" [Eventually, a famine came over the entire region, but Egypt had enough grain stored because of Joseph's leadership.] People from all over the world came to Egypt to buy grain, because the famine was so severe in their countries, including Joseph's brothers. They did not recognize Joseph, but at once he knew who they were. [After many more interactions, Joseph's brothers, Jacob's other sons, came to Jacob and said] Now we ask you to please forgive the terrible things we did. After all, we serve the same God that your father worshiped. When Joseph heard this, he started

crying, [and said] “you intended to harm me, but God intended it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many lives”. After Joseph said this, his brothers felt much better. [Jacob and his family came to Egypt, and lived under Joseph's protection for the rest of their lives.]
