#### **LUTHERAN DISASTER RESPONSE**

Over the past week several disasters have made the news. There has been loss of life and widespread damage.

- In Puerto Rico and the Caribbean, Hurricane Fiona has brought torrential rainfall and devasting flooding.
- In Alaska, the remnants of Typhoon Merbok have caused widespread flooding along the state's western coast.
- In Japan, Typhoon Nanmadol hit Kyushu, the country's southern most main island.
- In Papua New Guinea, a 7.7 magnitude earthquake hit on September 11 with ensuing aftershocks.
- In Pakistan, the summer monsoon flooding is causing a widespread humanitarian crisis.
