November is harvest season in West Africa, and since they mostly eat what they grow, it's a top priority to get those crops in. Rev. Habila from the Waja team reported that he harvested 13 bags of rice, and he will soon harvest his guinea corn (sorghum). In the meantime, the Waja team's checking of John has stalled, but I'm sure they will resume soon. I've been able to send them my comments on the first two chapters of John so far. Likewise, Tom has been sending the Lala team his comments on their translation of John in Lala. Please continue to pray for good progress on the harvest of crops and that the work on the Gospel of John in both Waja and Lala will result in a harvest of souls for Christ!

This year has been a tumultuous one for the whole world. We thank God for the peace we have in Jesus Christ and in His Word. "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us." John 1:14. NLT May God give you His peace that passes all understanding this Advent and Christmas season. Thank you for your faithful prayers for us and for the ministry of Bible translation, so that all may know the Word.
