Carl Hubbard read a Land Acknowledgement statement reminding us that Southeastern Wisconsin land originally home to indigenous people was taken from them.

Mayor Cory Mason and a student from Goodland Montessori were guest speakers.

Dave Backmann was the master of ceremonies.

The Save the Soil event was held on March 21 in the LCR Nature Prairie. The event took place to call attention to soil degradation and potential food insecurity worldwide. There were several speakers and about 75 people in attendance including students from Goodland Montessori School. LCR's own Emily Jacobson did projects with the children after the event.
