SUNDAY'S SERMON AND "GOSPEL TALK"

For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God; for the creation was subjected to futility, not of its own will but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to decay and will obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God. – Romans 8:19-21

[Jesus] put before [the crowds] another parable: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to someone who sowed good seed in his field; but while everybody was asleep, an enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and then went away." – Matthew 13:24-25

SUNDAY'S SERMON AND "GOSPEL TALK" (continued)

Does God allow evil to happen? Both our readings this week seem to suggest so. In Romans 8 God would seem to be the one who subjects creation to futility. Why? For the revealing of the freedom of the children of God. If God is a god of the power of force, then there's no question about freedom. God would simply make sure that bad things don't happen to whomever God favors. God wouldn't allow futility for god's friends. But if God is a god of the power of Love, then wouldn't God have to allow freedom? For true love never forces itself upon the beloved. It must allow the free choice of the beloved to not love in return.

In our Gospel Reading, the Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds, it seems like God allows an enemy to sow evil into the creation. Might I suggest along with the comic book character Pogo, that "we have met the enemy, and the enemy is us." God is love, and so God allows us to not love in return. The results in human history have been dire and deadly. For the most part, history reveals that we have chosen to believe in the false gods who wield powers of force. In doing so, we become our own worst enemies. We believe in our powers, and the false gods who justify them, to dominate others. We believe in the power to simply consume nature for our own purposes. That's why the rest of creation is waiting for us to get our act together. The whole of creation is groaning under the consequences of our false notions of freedom to believe in gods who justify our violence against each other and our earth home.



Please join us on Sunday, including the "Gospel Talk" between services – come early (9:05am) if you are a 10:00 worshiper – as we dig deeper into a revitalized Gospel message of Jesus faithfully loving the true God who is Love. Our broken world needs us to claim the revelation of our true freedom as loving service! Not forceful domination! (Hint: this revelation precludes things like racism, so-called Christian nationalism, selfishly consuming nature, and much more. It changes everything.)
