

For four weeks this winter, I invite you to rediscover the gift of Advent that comes without packages, ribbons, and bows by joining me in our Advent Study: "The Heart that Grew Three Sizes-Finding Faith in the Story of the Grinch!"

We don't know why the Grinch hated Christmas. We just know he did. In our Advent study we will explore the faith themes in the Christmas classic, How the Grinch Stole Christmas! Session 2, Sun. 12/3 at 9:15am OR Wed. 12/6 at 6:30pm: When Christmas Isn't Christmas




#### **SCRIP CARDS ARE AVAILABLE**
