

YES IT IS TIME ONCE AGAIN!!!!

The Youth of Resurrection will be hosting their tenth chili cook-off and dessert sale on February 18, 2024. The Youth at Resurrection will be attending the ELCA National Youth Gathering in New Orleans. Proceeds from this event will help make this possible.

WHAT DO WE NEED: Bring your crock pot, slow cooker, or Nesco full of your favorite homemade chili and any accompaniments you usually serve with your chili, i.e. sour cream, cheese, etc.

WHAT WILL WE SUPPLY: Bowls, spoons, napkins, Tums and beverages to cool down your palate.

Awards will be given to the most votes in three categories:

- Best afterburn
- Best nontraditional
- Best traditional. For our purposes traditional chili is ground beef and beans in a tomato-based sauce.
- One chili will be judged best overall

Cook-off rules:

- 1. Chili needs to be homemade.
- 2. Chefs should make their chili at home and transport to church.
- 3. Chili and chefs need to be in Fellowship Hall and ready to serve by 9:00 AM on day of cook-off.
- 4. For safety purposes chili cannot be left unattended. There should always be someone at each station to serve.
- 5. Tasting times are from 9:00am to 12:00 noon with category winners being announced after 12:00.
- 6. Sign up information coming soon.
