Over the last six months we have seen so many exciting things happening in our church with increased attendance, additional programming, and large group activities. The energy level and excitement are contagious for all who walk into our church. All of these changes are in alignment with our Vision and Mission. We are just at the beginning of our journey and continue to dream, vision, and plan out the next steps.

In Council we have been discussing the areas of staffing that need assistance. After much discussion and prayer the Resurrection Church Council unanimously agreed to call an additional Pastor here at Resurrection. We have not arrived at this decision lightly and have built out roles for two Pastors, how an additional Pastor will fit into our Organizational Structure, and the impact we expect on our Vision and Mission. At Council this week, after a lot of analysis and review by Dawn Jacobson, we discussed the details of our financial position and our ability to afford an additional full time Pastor.

We are planning to engage in the Call Process quickly in an effort to see if we can find someone who could join us in time for Fall Programming as one of the areas of responsibility will be Youth. As you know, the calling of a second Pastor requires "Special Congregational Meeting" so that we can have a congregational vote.
