What a wonderful turnout for the Women of the Vine Spring Gathering! If you missed this event, don't worry. They will be planning future events.

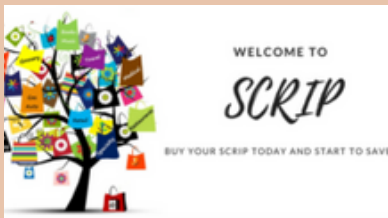
