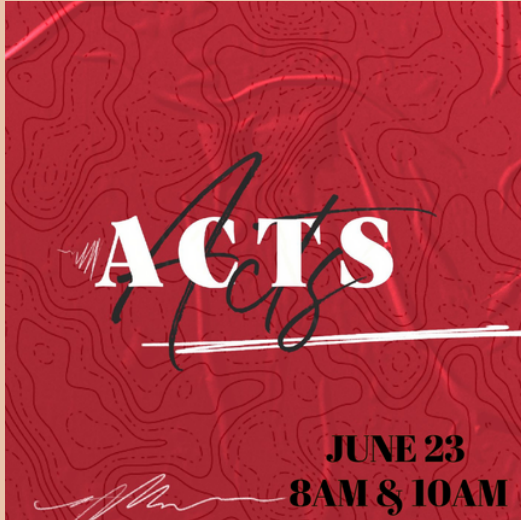

THE CHOSEN - SEASON 3 ADULT ED CLASSES

Hello! You are invited to a 8-session series watching and discussing the television program: The Chosen. Each of the sessions will take about 75-90 minutes to complete, depending on the length of the movie for that night (the Chosen clips we will watch in class vary in length from about 15-30 minutes). <https://watch.angelstudios.com/>. I would encourage using the Closed Captions when watching the show!

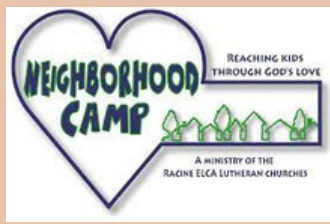
Each study session is composed of three parts:

1. Read Scripture prior to watching the movie clips (Scripture readings can be found in weekly study guides. The first study guide and class schedule is on the table outside of the office.)
2. Watch the movie
3. Discussion and Learning

This study is set up this way so that some of the Scripture referenced in the episode for that session is read prior to watching the movie. This will be of great help to any in the group who are not extremely well versed in various Bible stories – it will also help us pick up on some of the nuances and intricacies of the writing.

***Because of the length of time it takes to do all of this, if possible it's recommended that this "Read Prior" section be done even before arriving for the group study. We will offer two ways to gather for this study. **You can join us Monday's at 12pm or 7pm beginning June 24th! Sign up at**

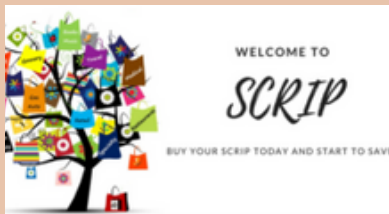
