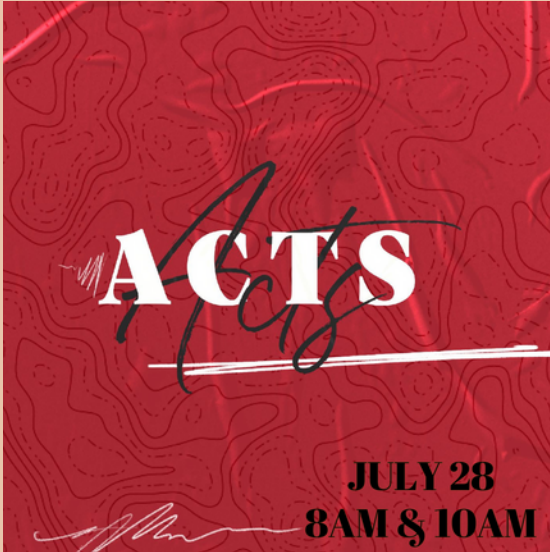

 - Ticket to the game (Great Seats!)

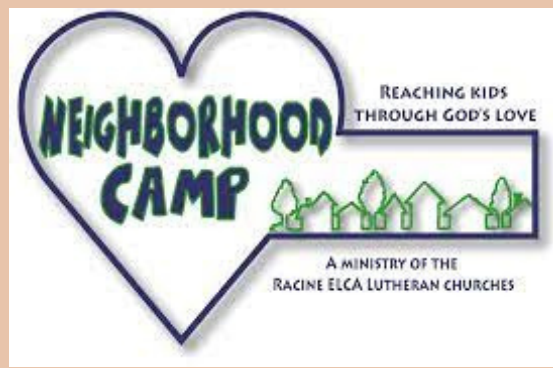
Sign-up sheet will be available in the gathering area so we can begin getting a count.
