The Youth of Resurrection will be hosting their 11th Annual Chili Cook Off and Dessert Sale on Sunday, March 30. Proceeds from the Chili Cook Off will go to future youth mission trips.

**WHAT DO WE NEED:** Bring your crock pot, slow cooker, or Nesco full of your favorite homemade chili and any accompaniments you usually serve with your chili, i.e. sour cream, cheese, etc.

**WHAT WE WILL SUPPLY:** Bowls, spoons, napkins, Tums and beverages to cool down your palate.

**Awards will be given to the most votes in these categories:**

- Best afterburn
- Best nontraditional
- Best traditional. For our purposes, traditional chili is ground beef and beans in a tomato based sauce.
- One chili will be judged best overall

**Cook off rules:**

1. Chili needs to be homemade.
2. Chefs should make their chili at home and transport to church.
3. Chili and chefs need to be in Fellowship Hall and ready to serve by 9am.
4. For safety purposes, chili cannot be left attended. There should always someone at each station to serve.
5. Tasting times are from 9am-12pm with category winners being announced at 12pm.
